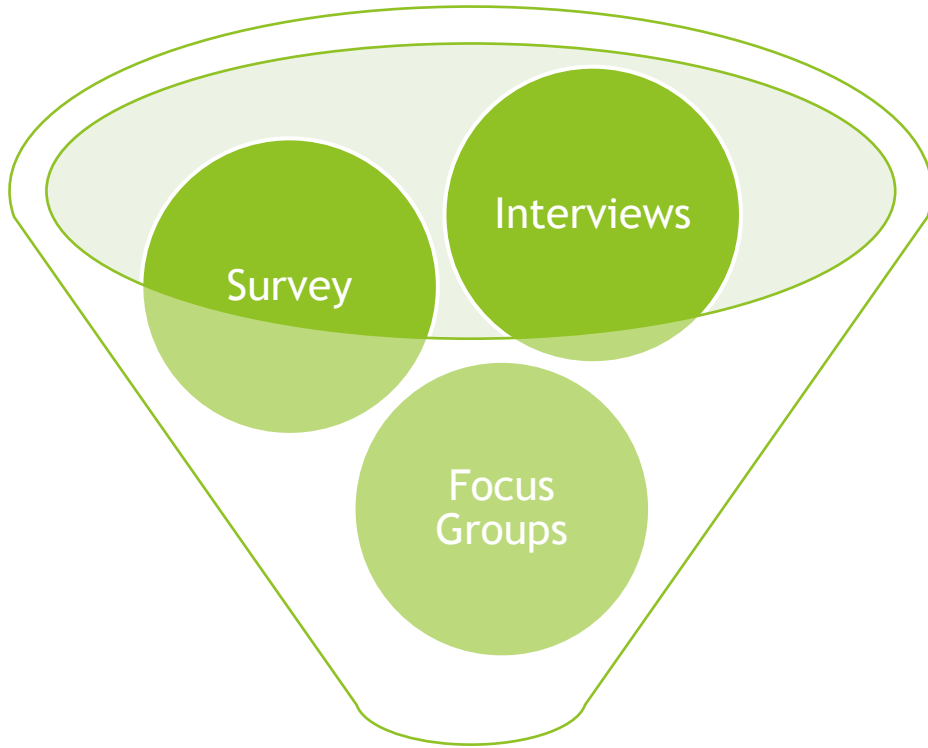
A Report to the OOA Districts

Project Background

- ▶ 2013 - joint meeting OOA, OU-HCOM, CORE Executive Committees to develop a common vision
- ▶ December 2015
 - ▶ OHF and OOF grants to support facilitator Josh Mintz
 - ▶ Review and comparison of OOA strategic plan with strategic plans of allied organizations (OU-HCOM, CORE, OHF, AOA)
 - ▶ Ohio key informant interviews (10 informants)
 - ▶ An OOA Stakeholder survey (~400 respondents)
 - ▶ Board, Student and GME Focus groups during the 2016 Symposium
 - ▶ Facilitated Strategic Summit in May 2016 with stakeholder representatives

Results

- ▶ Informant Interviews
 - ▶ Demonstrate clearly the value to the members, public and healthcare systems
- ▶ Stakeholder Survey
 - ▶ Focus on prevention and wellness including increased access to care
 - ▶ Maintain osteopathic identity and distinctiveness
 - ▶ Promote the use of OPP and OMT as an integral part of practice
- ▶ Focus groups during symposium- OOA Board members, osteopathic medical students and GME representatives
 - ▶ Students were clear - need “just-in-time” services to be relevant
 - ▶ Demonstrate how DO’s are *different*
 - ▶ Offer “Introduction to Osteopathic Medicine” for MDs and other providers
 - ▶ Return to our “Roots” - increase utilization of OMT and OPP
